‘Creating Community Care Cells’

- . It is formed and established independently by groups of neighbors.
- . Participation is completely voluntary.
- . Persons within a given neighborhood area decide they want to form a Neighborhood Watch “Care” Ring group.
- . The neighborhood group discusses issues and concerns important to them in areas of **‘personal’** safety and security, **‘property’** safety and security, **‘crime prevention’** and **‘preparedness’**. A priority is that assistance and care can be provided by neighbors in times of need.
- . An action plan is developed with support, resources and any training necessary provided through the Cumberland County Sheriff’s Department.
- . The group determines that they will exchange addresses, phone and e-mail contact information. Usually a coordinator/ team of 2 coordinators assume responsibility for organizing contact information for the group and plan activities/meetings as needs emerge. Coordinators are part of the NW”C”R Community Coalition and receive and send information through the Coaliton web-site or by e-mail.
- . One annual meeting must be held each year.
