



Steps to Form and join a Fairfield Glade Neighborhood Watch Group (FGNW)

1. Define the Neighborhood Area, typically between 10 and 50 households/homes. Identify who would be the volunteer.
2. Canvas neighbors' to see if they would be interested in forming a group. Proceed when having the majority of neighbors support.
3. If required, have an informal meeting of the neighbors to gain an understanding of the program. This informal meeting can be in conjunction with the kickoff meeting referenced in step 4.
4. The newly formed FGNW group attends a kickoff meeting presented by FGNW and local law enforcement, if available.
