Are you experienced in construction or home improvement? *Fairfield Glade Resident Services* (FGRS) invites you to become a part of our *Home Safety Team*! Your skills can make a real difference in our community, helping neighbors remain safe in their homes. The *Home Safety Assistance Service* (HSA) supports Fairfield Glade residents by providing guidance and resources for enhancing home safety. This Program is specifically designed to assist individuals who are unable to implement safety measures themselves, due to physical limitations or other circumstances beyond their control.

Program Overview

Home Safety volunteers assess homes and suggest improvements to increase safety. Homeowners are responsible for the cost of materials, while FGRS supplies volunteer labor for the necessary work. The main objective is to help Fairfield Glade residents continue to live safely in their homes, by leveraging the skills and talents of our volunteers.

Team Activities + Examples of What the Team Does

- Installing grab bars around the toilet
- Installing grab bars in the tub or shower
- Securing handrails on stairs
- Installing ramps at entrance doors
- Adding handrails at entrance doors and other locations inside and outside the home, as needed
